French II 1st Quarter

- Review verbs in present tense
- Review past tense

- Introduce your friends to other people

French II 2nd Quarter

- Describe weekend activities
- Using public transportation
- Describe what you see when you go for a walk or a drive
- Talk about what happened in the past
- Describe the meals you eat
- Shop for food in a market
- Express what you want to do, what you can do, and what you must do
- Reading in French – scanning for cognates
- Culture: Using the Paris Metro, where French people shop for food, what kinds of foods are served in French and Quebecois restaurants

French II 3rd Quarter

- Describe and discuss various forms of entertainment
- Talk about people you know and describe your relationship with them
- Extend, accept, and turn down invitations
- Talk about daily routines with reflexive verbs
- Using compliment pronouns
- Using the imperfect tense to describe habitual actions from the past
- Describe parts of the body and physical features
