French IV 1st Quarter

- Review verbs in present tense
- Review past tense
- Review imperfect
- Review conditional
- Review future tenses
- Review questions and interrogative words
- Speaking: describe situations in the past and future using correct verb forms
- Reading: Scanning for cognates and using context to figure out meaning
- Listening: Using spoken cues to decipher meaning from native French speakers.

French IV 2nd Quarter

- Grammar: Using the subjunctive with expressions of doubt, emotion, etc.
- Understand background and culture of a French film
- Decode basic language patterns used by native speakers in a French film
- Use cognates and context to read and understand native French
- Understand basic French idioms
- Writing: practice of writing skills in response to film.
- Culture: geography and history of France as it pertains to native French film.

French IV 3rd Quarter

- French literature
- Grammar: recognize the simple past
- Reading a short children's novel: Le Petit Prince with guidance in order to decipher meaning and to differentiate between verb tenses (B Year)
- Reading short stories in French to decipher meaning and differentiate between verb tenses
- Using cognates and context to guide reading
- Recognize reason and context for choice of verb structures
- Respond to reading through short writings, projects, and speaking activities

French IV 4th Quarter

- French film for listening skills followed by unscripted speaking response in French
- Speaking focus: express ideas and formulate opinions and commentaries using only French
- Evaluating situations and people
- Culture: children and teenagers in France, famous French poets, influence of French literature in the world as these things pertain to native French film.
