

French Class Policies:

- 1) Do your homework **ON TIME**.
 - Students who do not complete their homework on time will serve an academic no-zero detention immediately after school the same day to complete their work.
 - 1/3 of the total worth of the assignment will be deducted for each day the work is late, including the day the assignment is due and not finished.

- 2) Go to your locker, use the restroom and get drinks before or after school, during the passing period, or during your lunch. There will be no passes given from French class for any reason at any time.
 - Students who have an absolute emergency and must leave the room to go to the restroom will make up that time immediately after school the same day starting at 2:30.

- 3) Bring your supplies to class with you. Mrs. Erickson-Betz is not going to loan you paper, pencils, books, etc.
 - Students who do not bring their supplies will have participation points deducted from their total participation score. Bringing your supplies to class is part of being prepared for a high school course.

- 4) Keep your hands and negative comments to yourself.

Earning Your Grade:

This class is graded on total points. Students earn points by doing homework, taking quizzes and tests*, completing projects, and participating** positively in class without causing disruptions.

*Quarterly assessments are worth 10% of each quarter's grade. Ultimately, this totals 20% of a student's final semester grade.

**Participation is calculated out of 100 possible points per quarter. Speaking and participation are critical to success in a foreign language class.

Tardy Policy:
