### French I:

Monday – Write your own schedule (This MUST be completed in class and turned in before you leave)

Wednesday – Telling time with minutes – making paper plate clocks for time practice

### French II:

Monday – Focus on pronunciation for clarity of communication with past tense using avoir as the helping verb: in class activities for informal assessment of understanding and pronunciation
